DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session was commenced at the hour of 9:00 A.M. on the 17th day of July, 2013 and published pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart, Johnson and Swinney. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk and Scott Cotton, Dawes County Extension. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Swinney, seconded by Johnson, approving the agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Swinney and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Correspondences included a letter from NIRMA requesting payment of insurance deductible relevant to the Heiting case. Minutes of the July 03, 2013 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Swinney, approving the minutes with the following correction to wit: Ben Rivera, not Vic Rivera as recorded. Roll call vote, Ayes: Swinney, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney, joined the meeting in progress. Claims were reviewed by the Board. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Swinney, approving all claims. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Swinney. Nays: None. Motion carried. In other business the Board reviewed the 2nd quarter loss reports which will be forwarded onto the Safety Committee for review. The Board then reviewed and approved the monthly fee/mileage reports of the various offices and approved them by general consent of the Board. The Treasurers semi-annual report was accepted by the Board and will be placed on file. Kerri Rempp, The Chadron Record, joined the meeting in progress. The Board discussed representation at the Chadron State Park meeting. Commissioner Stewart will represent Dawes County at the meeting. Discussion ensued re: setting dates for budget meetings with Elected/Appointed Officials. The Board will start meeting with these individuals on August 05, 2013 commencing at 9:00 A.M. in the former County Courtroom located in the basement of the Courthouse. All Elected/Appointed Officials will be notified as to their scheduled time. Public Comment ensued with Commissioner Swinney giving updates relevant to the Tourism Board activities. The Board also took this time to publically thank Ted Kienitz for his time dedicated to watering the courtyard; the LDS Young Women and Men and Pack 302 Boy Scouts for mulching around the courtyard trees. The County appreciates all the time and labor donated by the citizens of Dawes County.

At 9:51 A.M. Larry Hankin, Highway Superintendent, met with the Board. Road updates included the following to wit: All road crew members attended motor grader/CDL training at Chadron State College. District 1-maintenance is completed on Bartlett and Stockade Roads. Slim Buttes Road is scheduled for maintenance. District 2-East River Road maintenance is in progress. The plan is to go east to west to avoid tearing the roads up. District 3-Crews are doing culvert work on West Ash Creek Road and still cleaning up tree limbs, etc. Blading and pothole repair is in progress in the Whitney area and on Whitney Lake Road. Crusher-The Crusher is located East of Chadron and averaging 180 yards of crushed rock per day. Weed Department-Spraying is temporarily on hold until such time the temperatures go down a bit so the chemical can absorb into the weeds being sprayed. The part-time help is mowing ditches. Mr. Hankin presented updates relevant to the planned

Bethel Loop Bridge project. FFP (Federal Funds Purchase) funding was discussed amongst the Board Members and Mr. Hankin.

At 10:36 A.M. Venita Quamme, Custodial Assistant, met with the Board. She reported her hours of work are 1:30 P.M. to 8:30 P.M. The Board informed her she must take a ½ hour dinner break and has the option to take two 15 minute breaks as well. Service Master will be contacted to provide an estimate to clean the lobby floors in the Courthouse. A vacuum and electric leaf blower will be purchased as well.

There being no further business before the Dawes County Board of Commissioners the meeting adjourned at 11:00 A.M. The next meeting will be August 07, 2013 beginning at 9:00 A. M. with a Board of Equalization Meeting followed by the Commissioner Meeting at approximately 9:20 A.M. The meeting(s) will be held in the Commissioners Room at the Courthouse. A current agenda for the meeting(s) is kept on file in the County Clerk's office during normal business hours for inspection, but will close by 3:00 P.M. on Friday, August 02, 2013. The meetings of the Dawes County Commissioners are open to the public.
