DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners meeting in regular session was commenced at the hour of 11:05 A.M. on the 18th day of October, 2011 in the former county courtroom and published pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Johnson. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners' Johnson and Stewart with Swinney absent. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk; Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney; Terry Cogdill and Jay King. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those present. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, amending the agenda to include a zoning board appointment previously scheduled but not included on the agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Minutes of the October 05, 2011 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, approving the minutes as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, approving all claims. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Public Comment ensued with Terry Cogdill asking the Board for permission to hold Wreaths across America ceremony honoring all Veterans past and present. The ceremony itself will take place at the Veteran's Memorial located at the Courthouse on Saturday, December 10, 2011. The Board approved the request. In other business the Board reviewed a letter of resignation submitted by Dean Carpenter who served on the travel board. Two (2) individuals, Linda Teahon and Shirley Reed submitted letters of interest in serving. Motion by Stewart, seconded by Johnson, appointing Shirley Reed to the travel board. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. A zoning board appointment was also discussed. Motion by Johnson, seconded by Stewart, appointing Dusty Dexter to the zoning board. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. The County Clerk presented a surplus request of two (2) old computers that will be discarded. Motion by Stewart, seconded by Johnson, approving the surplus request. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. The County Clerk then presented information relevant to the 2011 Working Women addition to the Chadron Record. The Board approved an eighth (1/8) page ad recognizing those women employed by Dawes County. Adam Edmund informed the Board that prior year's taxes can't be forgiven by the Board per State Statute, however; they can be stricken from the tax rolls for collection purposes. Mr. Edmund recommended the Board proceed with striking several uncollected distress warrants from the tax rolls. The last order of business was reviewing the third (3rd) quarter NIRMA loss reports and approving monthly fee reports of the various offices.

There being no further business before the Dawes County Board of Commissioners the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 12:00 P.M. The next meeting will be November 02, 2011 beginning at 9:00 A.M. with a Board of Equalization Meeting, followed by the Commissioner Meeting at approximately 9:20 A.M. Both meetings will be held in the Commissioners room at the Courthouse. A current agenda for the meeting(s) is kept on file in the County Clerk's office during normal business hours for inspection, but will close by 3:00 P.M. on Friday, October 28, 2011.
