The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart and Johnson. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk; Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney and Kerri Rempp, The Chadron Record. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Commissioner Johnson moved to approve the Agenda. Commissioner Stewart seconded the motion. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, excusing Commissioner Rivera from the meeting. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, to approve the October 25, 2016 minutes as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed by the Board. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, approving all claims as presented. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Correspondences acknowledged by the Board included a letter from the Nebraska Crime Commission informing the Board all out-of-state travel is eliminated on all Community-based Juvenile Services Grants and there is also the possibility that all unspent funds as of June 30, 2017 will be returned or deobligated to the Nebraska Crime Commission. There was no one from the public wishing to comment. The Board reviewed and approved by general consent all fee/mileage reports of the various departments.

At 9:35 A.M. Kristina Harter, Tourism Director, met with the Board. She informed the Board the travel board recently approved a grant in the amount of \$1,038.66 to Chadron Festival of Quilts. She also reported July 2016 receipts were down about \$3,000.00 from the prior year. Discussion ensued regarding the Farmers Market. No action was taken.

At 9:45 A.M. Larry Hankin, Highway Superintendent, met with the Board. Road updates included the following to wit: District 1-Bordeaux Road about done and crews are hauling pit run. They will move to McHenry Road next week. Scott Peters has

been hired in District 1. District 2-Crews finished Hough Road, Squaw Mound Road is pulled and ready for rock. Crews will go to Highland Road next. Tony Brierly has been hired in District 2. District 3-Crews working on a culvert project on Toadstool Road and will move to West Belmont next. Crusher-Stumph's pit is stripped and will be ready to crush rock next week. All crews will be working on Intersection and corners on various roads.

At 10:20 A.M. Mike Kesselring, The Cook Shack met with the Board. He requested Board approval for a SDL (Special Designated License) to serve beer and wine on December 06, 2016 from 4:00 P.M. to midnight at the Buffalo Barracks at Fort Robinson. The event is being held to recognize Crawford Public School employees. Commissioner Johnson moved to approve the SDL request of the Cook Shack as presented by Mike Kesselring. Commissioner Stewart seconded the motion. Roll was called, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried.

There being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 10:25 A.M. The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be November 22, 2016 beginning at 9:00 A.M. The meeting will be held in the former county courtroom located in the basement of the Courthouse.
