The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Board of Equalization in regular session was commenced at the hour of 8:28 A.M. on the 11th day of August, 2015 and published pursuant to public notice as required by law and or posted. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart and Rivera. Commissioner Johnson was excused. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk; Lindy Coleman, Assessor and Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those present. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Rivera, seconded by Stewart, approving the Agenda. Roll call, Ayes: Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Minutes of the July 14, 2015 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Stewart, approving the minutes as published. Roll call, Ayes: Stewart and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Minutes of the July 15, 2015 Property Valuation Protests were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Rivera, approving the minutes as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Lindy Coleman, Assessor, presented tax correction #'s 4948-4949 for the Boards review and approval. Motion by Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Stewart, to approve tax corrections #'s 4948-4949 and directed Chairman Stewart to sign. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried.

There being no further business to be conducted by the Dawes County Board of Equalization the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 8:44 A.M. The next meeting will be held on September 8, 2015 at 8:30 A.M. The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session was commenced at the hour of 8:50 A.M. on the 11th day of August, 2015 and published pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk and Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, approving the agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, approving the minutes of the July 28, 2015

meeting with the following correction to wit: 16,000 gallons of chemical sprayed, not 16 gallons as recorded. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Commissioner Johnson moved to approve all claims with the exception of claim#15080048 to Petersen Drug in the amount of \$4.19. Commissioner Rivera seconded the motion. Roll was called, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Public Comment ensued with Ingrid Farreras thanking the Board for the follow-up on the culvert issue. An autogate will also be pulled on the East end of the property.

At 9:15 A.M. Larry Hankin, Highway Superintendent, met with the Board. Road updates included the following to wit: District 1-hauling gravel on Slim Buttes Road, McHenry Road work will begin next week, pit run gravel on Kudrna Road and mowing is taking place. District 2-East River Road is pulled from Hollibaugh's East, Oetken Road project will begin the end of this week and Table Road is being prepared for rock. District 3-hauling gravel on Four Mile Road, two blades on Lone Tree Road pulling shoulders, Toadstool Road work will begin next week, plans to install a culvert on Snook Road and mowing is in progress. Mr. Hankin presented the Federal-Aid Urban Boundary Update Maps. Discussion ensued. The County boundary maps are good to go according to Hankin. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to direct the Highway Superintendent to respond to the request and sign the NDOR (Nebraska Department of Roads) Federal-Aid Urban boundary maps. Roll was called, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. The County Clerk informed the Board the Post Office will be changing hours of collection to an earlier time. This will affect Board packets going out prior to meetings. The County Clerk will begin closing the Agenda for all meetings at noon the Thursday prior to the meeting(s) on Tuesday. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) agreement was reviewed by the Board and Adam Edmund. The agreement is relevant to space occupied by Health and Human Services in Chadron. Commissioner Johnson moved to accept the agreement terms at \$14,532.00 annually until June 30, 2020 and directed the Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement. Commissioner Rivera seconded the motion for passage. Roll was called, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Monthly fee/mileage reports were reviewed and approved by the Board. Also reviewed and approved by the Board were Distress Warrant reports from the Sheriff and Treasurer respectively. The last order of business was approval of paying PADD dues for 2015-2016. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to continue PADD dues in the amount of \$1367.26 for 2015-2016. Roll was called, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried.

There being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 10:30 A.M. The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be August 25, 2015 beginning at 8:30 A.M. The meeting will be held in the Commissioner room at the Courthouse. A current agenda is available at the Clerk's Office during normal business hours but will close at 12:00 P.M.
