## CHADRON, NEBRASKA August 22, 2017 DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session was commenced at the hour of 9:01 A.M. on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2017 pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk and Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those present. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, approving the Agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart, Nays; None, Motion carried, Motion by Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, to approve the minutes of the August 08, 2017 meeting as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson, Nays: None. Motion carried. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to approve minutes of the budget meeting held on August 15, 2017 with the following correction to wit: \$8,000.00 total budgeted for part-time security. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, approving all claims with the exception of claim#17080205 payable to River A Holdings in the amount of \$249.00. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Stewart, moved to approve claim#17080205 payable to River A Holdings in the amount of \$249.00. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Johnson with Rivera abstaining from the vote. Nays: None. Motion carried. There being no one from the Public for Public Comment, the Board reviewed all inventories presented by the various departments. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to acknowledge receipt of inventories and approving content thereof. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. A surplus request from the Veteran's Service Office was reviewed. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to surplus a 2012 Dodge Grand Caravan. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. The Board briefly discussed the audit for 2017. Commissioner Stewart will contact the county's current audit firm to set up the 2017 audit. Commissioner Rivera introduced Resolution No. 2017-17 transferring \$9000.00 from the General Fund-0100 to the Veteran's Aid Fund-1900. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. Roll was called, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Resolution No. 2017-16 was introduced by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, authorizing the 2017/2018 allocation of real and personal property tax to the following political subdivisions to wit: Dawes County Ag Society-\$36,086.23; Chadron Rural Fire District #2-\$109,262.40 and Crawford Rural Fire District #4-\$133,851.54. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. In other business the Board approved by general consent all department monthly fee/mileage reports.

At 10:05 A.M. Larry Hankin, Highway Superintendent, approached the Board. Commissioner Rivera reported he received a positive comment from Gary Fickel re: Antelope Road. District 1-culvert repair work done on Table Road; bridge cleanup at Schmechel's and concrete cleanup. District 2-Highland and Table Roads have been rocked. District 3-putting rock on Lawrence Road, then onto Whitney Lake Road; two (2) culverts were replaced on West Ash Creek Road. Crusher-at Johnson's pit crushing rock. Various road closures were discussed at length with the Highway Superintendent. Mr. Hankin reported he is ready to advertize for two (2) full-time positions in the Roads Department. The Board told him to proceed with hiring two (2) full-time positions.

At 10:30 A.M. Interviews for Dawes County Treasurer ensued. Also present was Kerri Rempp, The Chadron Record and Mandy Brice, HR Department. Three candidates were interviewed by the Board. They included Chelsie Sparks, Rhonda Schuleuning and Cindi Jacobson-Brinton. At 11:47 A.M. a motion was made by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, to enter executive session for legal reasons. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. The County Clerk, Kerri Rempp and Mandy Brice all left the meeting in progress. At 12:12 P.M. Commissioner

Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to reconvene to regular session. No action was taken during executive session. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried.

At 12:13 P.M there being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting. The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be September 12, 2017 beginning at 9:00 A.M. with a Board of Equalization Meeting, followed by the Commissioner Meeting at approximately 9:20 A.M. Both meetings will be held in the former courtroom located in the basement of the Courthouse. A current agenda is available at the Clerk's Office during normal business hours but will close at 12:00 P.M., September 07, 2017.
