Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Johnson, seconded by Rivera, approving the Agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Rivera, seconded by Johnson, approving the minutes of the June 12, 2018 meeting as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. No correspondence was received. No tax corrections were presented for review and approval.

There being no further business to be conducted by the Dawes County Board of Equalization the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 9:02 A.M. The next meeting will be held on August 14, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session was commenced at the hour of 9:04 A.M. on the 10th day of June, 2018 pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk and Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, approving the amended Agenda items added twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting. These items being use of the Courtyard for the Washington D.C. kid's barbeque on July 14, 2018 and approval of Tourism Board grants. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, approving the minutes of the June 26, 2018 meeting as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, to approve all claims as presented. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. The Board reviewed a letter from the Tourism Board advising them of NE. State Statute 81-3717 which allows the use of Visitor Improvement funds for promoting Northwest Nebraska. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve the advice of the Travel Board to use Visitor Improvement funds

to promote Northwest Nebraska and approval of the Travel Board mission statement. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. A copy of the Travel Board mission statement is attached to these minutes. There being no correspondence or individuals for Public Comment the Board reviewed a surplus request from the Veteran's Service Office. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to approve the surplus request of the Veteran's Service Office to surplus office equipment and Law books. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. The Board reviewed a cooperative agreement between the Dawes County Sheriff's Office, USDA Forest Service, Nebraska National Forest and Pine Ridge Job Corp. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve the cooperative agreement between the Dawes County Sheriff's Office, USDA Forest Service, Nebraska National Forest and Pine Ridge Job Corp. and directed the Chairman to sign such. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Two (2) Tourism Grants were reviewed to wit: Dawes County Fair in the amount of \$1500.00 and Mud Truck Racing in the amount of \$2000.00. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve both Tourism Grants as presented. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. The Board also reviewed and approved by general consent monthly fee/mileage reports of the various departments.

At 9:40 A.M. The Board recessed to conduct a quarterly jail inspection. The Board reconvened to regular session at 10:04 A.M. The Board reviewed an application to use the Courtyard on July 14, 2018 for a Washington D.C. kid's fund raiser. They will be doing a barbeque on the Courthouse lawn. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to approve the application of the Washington D.C. kid's fundraiser. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Kerri Rempp, The Chadron Record, joined the meeting.

At 10:09 A.M. Larry Hankin, Highway Superintendent, met with the Board. Road Updates included the following to wit: All shops blading roads. District 1-North end of Egan Road is done; pulled the North end of Pineview Road back to Beaver Road; scraper will be back this week and the 140G had a mow board replaced. District 2-Fill on Bach Road is finished; ½ mile on the South end of Squaw Mound Road is pulled and ready for gravel. District 3-Hauled to blow outs on Four Mile Road; Mansfield Road will have water issues addressed and Crews will be on Eleson Road this Thursday. Crusher-Crushing rock at Bartlett pit; replaced the starter on the jaw; screener is about done according to Hankin. Monthly rental for a screener will run approximately \$14,000.00-\$15,000.00 per month. Rental of another loader was discussed and will be considered. Bids to haul rock out of Hills Materials were discussed. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to direct the Highway Superintendent to secure bids for rock hauling. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Mr. Hankin reported two (2) new hires to wit: Rocky Lemmon in District 2 and JR Kelly in District 1. .

At 10:30 A.M. there being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting. The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be July 24, 2018 beginning at 9:00 A.M. The meeting will be held in the former County Courtroom located in the basement of the Courthouse.
