The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session was commenced at the hour of 9:04 A.M. on the 3rd day of July, 2013 and published pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart, Johnson and Swinney. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Swinney, amending the agenda to include Resolution No. 2013-14. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Swinney and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney, joined the meeting in progress. Minutes of the June 09, 2013 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Swinney, seconded by Johnson, approving the minutes as recorded. Roll call vote, Ayes: Swinney, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Resolution No. 2013-14 was introduced by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, transferring \$100,000.00 from the General Fund to the Road Fund to meet expenditures for 2013/2014 budget. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Swinney. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Kerri Rempp, The Chadron Record and Roxie Graham-Marski, KCSR, joined the meeting in progress. Motion by Commissioner Swinney, seconded by Johnson, approving all claims. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Stewart and Swinney. Nays: None. Motion carried. The Board reviewed two subgrant agreements between Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, the County Attorney and District Court pertaining to child support enforcement and reimbursement thereof. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Swinney, approving the subgrant agreement between DHHS and District Court and directing the Chairman to sign such. Roll call vote, Ayes: Swinney, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Commissioner Swinney, seconded by Johnson, approving the subgrant agreement between DHHS and the County Attorney and directing the Chairman to sign such. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Swinney. Nays: None. Motion carried.

At 9:47 A.M. Public comment ensued with Commissioner Swinney reporting the Travel Board is in receipt of a letter thanking them for a \$2,000.00 donation to the Post Playhouse. He also reported he has received an invitation to attend a stakeholder meeting on July 25, 2013 at Chadron State Park beginning at 9:00 A.M. Discussion ensued regarding representation from Dawes County at the meeting. A decision will be made at the July 17, 2013 Commissioner Meeting as to whom will attend the meeting on Dawes County's behalf. In other business the Board reviewed a letter received from the Crawford Chamber of Commerce re: dues. Motion by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, to donate like amounts to the Chadron and Crawford Chambers of Commerce. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Swinney and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. A Board appointment to the Crawford American Legion Post 138 Veterans Board was reviewed by the Board. Motion by Commissioner Swinney, seconded by Johnson, approving the appointment of John Stumph to the Board replacing Vic Riveria. Roll call vote, Ayes: Swinney, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. The Board reviewed and approved monthly fee/mileage reports of the various offices.

There being no further business before the Dawes County Board of Commissioners the meeting adjourned at 10:03 A.M. The next meeting will be July 17, 2013 beginning at 9:00 A. M. The meeting will be held in the Commissioners Room at the Courthouse.
