

UPCOMING PROJECTS

Bridge Projects:

County Bridge Match Program – This program addresses the Structurally Deficient Bridges across Nebraska. Dawes County submitted three projects for the first year and all were approved. The three projects called for the bridges to be removed and replaced with corrugated metal pipes having steel head and wing walls. The state match for the three projects is estimated at \$79,500.00. The additional funds to complete the projects will come from the Federal Funds Purchase Program (FFPP).

1) Lemmon Bridge- This project was completed on June 27, 2018 by Littrel Construction of Chadron, Nebraska at a cost of \$31,500.00 for labor and equipment. The culverts and headwalls were paid for by the (CBMP). The fill material was hauled using county forces and equipment.

2) Egan Bridge South -will be replaced with twin 84” culverts.

3) Egan Bridge North -will be replaced with twin 84” culverts.

The CBMP second year submission was for the replacement of the Redfern Bridge. This project was not selected this year, but will be re-submitted in the next round of proposals.

The Knueppel Bridge Project on Deadhorse Road was completed on June 25, 2018 by Fuller Construction of Chadron, Nebraska. The existing timber bridge was removed and replaced with twin 60” culverts at a bid price of \$91,052.50. The construction cost for this project will come from the (FFPP).

West Dakota Bridge-will be replaced with either a new bridge or multiple culverts depending upon what would be adequate and most cost effective. Source of funding will be determined after receiving an engineer’s estimate.
