The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Board of Equalization in regular session was commenced at the hour of 9:05 A.M. on the 12th day of June, 2018 and published pursuant to public notice as required by law and or posted. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk and Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those present. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Johnson, seconded by Rivera, approving the Agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Rivera, seconded by Johnson, approving the minutes of the May 08, 2018 meeting as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. No correspondence was received. Lindy Coleman, Assessor, presented tax correction #'s 5050 - 5052 for the Boards review and approval. Upon review of the tax corrections Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to approve tax corrections #'s 5050 - 5052 and directed the Chairman to sign such. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried.

At 9:11 A.M. Shellie Decker, Interim Treasurer, presented 25 vehicle exemption renewals for NCAP; 1 vehicle exemption renewal for Camp Norwesca and 1 vehicle exemption renewal for Bethlehem Lutheran Church for the Boards review and approval. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, moved to approve all vehicle exemption renewals presented to the Board and directed the Chairman to sign such. The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session was commenced at the hour of 9:17 A.M. on the 12th day of June, 2018 pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk; Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney and Connie Shell. Per LB 898 the Chairman announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, approving the Agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays:

None. Motion carried. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, approving the minutes of the May 29, 2018 meeting with the following corrections to wit: Satchell, not Fickel; tractor, not mower. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Rivera, to approve all claims as presented with the exception of claim#18060117 payable to River A Holdings in the amount of \$15,133.16. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, moved to approve claim#18060117 payable to River A Holdings in the amount of \$15,133.16. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart with Rivera abstaining from the vote. Nays: None. Motion carried.

At 9:40 A.M. Connie Shell, Twila Satchell, Darcy Hays and Jamie Rivera-Haas met with the Board. Connie Shell reported they were present to invite the Board to attend an up-coming silent crossing meeting in conjunction with the Railroad, DOT and the City of Crawford. Ms. Shell will advise of the date once it has been set. There being no one present for Public Comment, Commissioner Stewart reported on the recent County Board Workshop held in Kearney, NE. Candidates for Governor were introduced. The following topics were addressed at the conference: EEOC issues, planning & zoning relevant to wind and solar energy, wellness programs, NEMA/FEMA, opiate abuse issues, Build Nebraska Act relevant to bonding, school formulas and a Public Relations Consultant also met with Board Members. Commissioner Stewart reported the conference had a lot of useful information.

At 9:50 A.M. Don Fryda, APHIS, presented the 2019 APHIS contract for review and approval. The contract amount for 2019 is \$21,722.58 which reflects an increase in ariel hunting, pre-bait prices and poison oats. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve the 2019 APHIS contract in the amount of \$21,722.58 and directed the Chairman to sign such. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. In other business the Board reviewed a surplus request from the Clerk's Office. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, moved to surplus a 2003 computer. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Three (3) Travel Board Grants were reviewed to wit: Classics in the Park in the amount of \$2020.00; Crawford Chamber of Commerce re: 4th of July activities in the amount of \$1500.00 and Western Wild Life Art Show in the amount of \$2,000.00. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve all three (3) Grants as submitted. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Monthly fee/mileage reports of the various departments were approved by general consent of the Board.

At 10:10 A.M. there being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting. The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be June 26, 2018 beginning at 9:00 A.M. The meeting will be held in the Commissioner's room at the Courthouse. A current agenda is available at the Clerk's Office during normal business hours but will close at 12:00 P.M., June 21, 2018.
