DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session was commenced at the hour of 9:05 A.M. on the 30th day of December, 2019 pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Stewart. Roll was called and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Johnson and Stewart. Commission Rivera was excused from the meeting due to weather. Also present was Mandy Brice, Dawes County Payroll and Claims Clerk. Per LB 898, Commissioner Stewart announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Changes were made to the agenda. The 9:45 A.M. Executive Session was moved to the January 14, 2020 meeting. Board reports were also taken off the agenda. The 11:00 A.M. appointment for Robert Basse was canceled. Motion to approve the agenda with these changes by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the December 10, 2019 meeting. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Changes were made to claim 19120111 to Celeste Cattin. The code was changed from 0100-621-00-5-2510 to 0100-621-00-2-1700. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, moved to approve all claims with this change. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried.

At 9:22 A.M. Karl Dailey and Steve Crile entered the meeting. Public Comment ensued with Karl discussing that the IRS has made some changes and a matron is no longer able to be contracted service. A matron will have to be a part-time permanent Dawes County employee. Karl Dailey and Steve Crile discussed the grocery prices with the board and the reasons they switched to Cash-Wa from D&S Market. A savings of \$10,000-\$12,000 per year is an average of what was found.

The 9:30 A.M. appointment for Sam Dyer was a no-show.

At 9:37 A.M. Karl Dailey left the meeting. At 9:38 A.M. Steve Crile left the meeting. At 9:40 A.M. the board recessed for jail inspections.

At 10:02 A.M. the board reconvened regular session led by Commissioner Stewart and seconded by Commissioner Johnson. Amanda Vogl enter the meeting.

At 10:03 A.M. the Commissioners entered Executive Session. At 10:13 A.M. regular session reconvened with no action taken. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried.

At 10:15 A.M. there being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting. The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be January 14, 2020 beginning at 9:00 A.M with a Board of Equalization Meeting followed by the Commissioner Meeting at approximately 9:20 A.M. Both meetings will be held in the former County Courtroom located in the basement of the Courthouse.
