DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session, was commenced at the hour of 9:29 A.M. on the 8th day of September, 2020 pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Vic Rivera. Board Members present were Jake Stewart and Webb Johnson. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk. Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney, was excused. Per LB 898, Commissioner Rivera announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, moved to approve the Agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve the August 25 and August 28, 2020 Commissioner's Meetings noting August 11, 2020, not August 8, 2020 re: August 25, 2020 meeting. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, moved to approve all claims as submitted. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Correspondences acknowledged by the Board included Newsletters received from NNDC and NCAP. There being no one for Public Comment, Commissioner Stewart reported back re: communications data storage. Greg Yanker, City Manager will contact other city managers and Commissioner Stewart will contact other Commissioners in the area to establish a regional communications center. Discussion ensued. The Board reviewed and approved by general consent all monthly fee/mileage reports of the various departments. A Travel Board appointment was discussed. Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, moved to appoint Janelle Winkleman to fulfill the unexpired term of Alex Helmbrecht who resigned. The term ends in February of 2024. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. John Axtel, KCSR, joined the meeting. The Chairman declared the public input hearing re: 2020-2021 budget open at 10:00 A.M. There being no one from the Public to comment, the Chairman closed the hearing at 10:10 A.M.

At 10:11 A.M. Connie Shell, Mayor of Crawford, approached the Board with an invoice from Littrel Construction in the amount of \$9,611.00 to replace the waterline across the White River as it was struck. She asked the Board to assist with payment of the invoice due to the Roads involvement. The Board will take this under consideration. The Board reviewed two inventories received from the Treasurer and Crawford Law Enforcement. Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve both 2020 inventories as presented. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. The Board acknowledged receipt of a State Grant Award#20-EB-0614 in the amount of \$35,849.00 for a full-time social worker in the school system. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, moved to direct the Chairman to sign the Grant Award in the amount of \$35,849.00. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Stewart and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. A petition request from Phillip Lollar to install Centurylink lines to three residential areas was reviewed. Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, moved to allow petitioner, Phillip Lollar, to bore or cross under Beaver Valley Road with no trenching allowed. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Johnson and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. A gravel lease between Dawes County, Kristopher Pyle and KJR Farms, LLC was reviewed by the Board. Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve the gravel lease at \$2.00 per cubic foot between Dawes County, Kristopher Pyle and KJR Farms, LLC and directing the Chairman to sign the lease. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Rivera and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried.

At 9:45 A.M. there being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting. The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be September 22, 2020 beginning at 9:00 A.M. The meeting will be held in the Commissioners room located in the Courthouse.
