DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session, was commenced at the hour of 9:13 A.M. on the 10th day of November, 2020 pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was also set up on zoom and called to order by Chairman, Vic Rivera. Board Members present were Webb Johnson and Jake Stewart. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk; Adam Edmund, Deputy Co. Attorney via zoom and Levi Grant. Per LB 898, Commissioner Rivera announced the location of posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve the Agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Johnson, Stewart and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, moved to approve the October 27, 2020 minutes with the following correction to wit: BH Motor Grader, not VH Motor Grader as recorded. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Rivera and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Larry Hankin, Highway Superintendent, joined the meeting in progress. Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Stewart, moved to approve all claims as submitted. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Johnson and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. There wasn't any correspondence. Public Comment ensued with Alan Soester asking permission to install approaches on his land. He doesn't believe a culvert will be needed. The Board advised Mr. Soester the Highway Superintendent could explain the process. Mr. Soester met briefly with Mr. Hankin regarding the approaches. The Board recessed at 9:45 A.M. and reconvened to regular session at 9:51 A.M. The scheduled appointment at 9:45 A.M. was moved to the November 24, 2020 Commissioner meeting.

At 10:00 A.M. Larry Hankin, Highway Superintendent, presented specifications for a used motor grader for the Boards review. Discussion ensued. Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Johnson, directing the Highway Superintendent to use specifications presented and go to bid for a used motor grader. Roll call vote, Ayes; Johnson, Stewart and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Commissioner Stewart then introduced and read aloud Resolution No. 2020-32 regarding the 2020 Highway Superintendent certification. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Rivera and Johnson. Nays: None. Motion carried. Shop and equipment repairs were briefly discussed.

At 10:30 A.M. Jenny Nixon, UNL Extension, introduced Rob Eirich as the new Engagement Zone 1 Coordinator. Mr. Eirich explained UNL used to be based on Districts, however; those Districts have now become known as Zones. There are eleven (11) zones across the State of Nebraska. Mr. Eirich explained his duties include fostering talent and working with staff, connect with stakeholders and community engagement. He also briefly discussed the EDEN Program which is an emergency response program focused on emergency response education. Dawes County will house the individual for the EDEN program. There will be no other costs associated with this position.

At 10:45 A.M. there being no further business before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting. The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be November 24, 2020 beginning at 9:00 A.M. The meeting will be held in the Commissioners room located in the Courthouse. If zoom is set up, individuals on the Agenda will be notified as to how to access the meeting.
