DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session, was commenced at the hour of 9:20 A.M. on the 12th day of October, 2021 pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jake Stewart. Board Members present were Vic Rivera and Levi Grant. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk; Adam Edmund, Deputy County Attorney and Wade Yada, Highway Superintendent. Per LB 898, Commissioner Stewart announced posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act is located on the door in the Commissioner Room by the United States Flag. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Grant, seconded by Rivera approving the agenda noting the cancellation of three scheduled appointments and clarifying for the record that Public Comment is held on the second Commissioner meeting of each month, with road updates being on both agendas. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Grant and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Minutes of the September 28, 2021 Commissioner meeting were reviewed. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Grant, moved to approve the minutes as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Grant, Stewart and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Motion by Commissioner Grant, seconded by Rivera to approve all claims as presented. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Rivera and Grant. Nays: None. Motion carried. Monthly fee/mileage reports of the various departments were approved by general consent of the Board. Wade Yada, Highway Superintendent, presented road updates to wit: District 1 has one 1.5 more days left to gravel Ormesher road; District 2 is graveling Squaw Mound Road and culverts are going in on Hollibaugh road; District 3 is laying gravel on Haynes Road. Mr. Yada reported MSHA training has been completed by Road Crew Members.

Public Comment ensued with Joe Headrick. Also present was Sheriff Karl Dailey, Mark Werner and Anthony Storbeck. Mr. Headrick read aloud a letter he sent to the State Board of Education and a letter written by Matt Innis. Concerns he expressed were sex education in schools; restoration of respect for Law Enforcement and announcement of a petition for Voter ID. Mr. Headrick had many suggestions to implement his plan. Some of these suggestions included getting Law Enforcement in Schools; educate our students on the Constitution of the United States; get students involved as Legislative Aides and encourage County, City, Schools and Law Enforcement to be on Board as well. Discussion ensued. Copies of the letters read aloud are available with minutes in the Clerk's Office during normal business hours. Sheriff Dailey reported Mobius has IT services available for the County. The Board recessed at 10:12 A.M. and reconvened to regular session at 10:17 A.M. An agreement between DHHS and Dawes County for office space and rent in the amount of \$14,532.00 payable to DHHS was read aloud by the Chairman. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Grant, moved to accept the agreement terms and directed the Chairman to sign the perpetual agreement. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Grant and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. In other business the Board accepted two bids for surplus property to wit: Martha Quay-\$20.00 for a wooden table and Sam Wellnitz-\$10.00 for 2 grey tables and a small wood desk. Commissioner Grant, seconded by Rivera, moved to award both bids for surplus items as presented. Roll call vote, Ayes: Grant, Stewart and Rivera. Nays: None. Motion carried. A Tourism Grant in the amount of \$2000.00 for the Crawford Cattle Call was reviewed by the Board. Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Grant, moved to approve the Grant in the amount of \$2000.00 for the Crawford Cattle Call. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart, Rivera and Grant. Nays: None. Motion carried. Commissioner Rivera discussed designated smoking areas at the Courthouse. More signage will be installed.

At 11:00 A.M. a motion to enter executive session for the purpose of conduction performance appraisals was made by Commissioner Rivera, seconded by Grant. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Grant and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. At 11:55 A.M a motion was made by Commissioner Grant, seconded by Rivera, to reconvene to regular session with no action taken. Roll call vote, Ayes: Rivera, Grant and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. There being no further business before the Board, the meeting adjourned at 11:57: A.M.

The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be held on October 26, 2021 beginning at 9:00 A.M. with the regular Commissioner Meeting. The meeting will be held in the Commissioner room. The agenda will close at noon on October 21, 2021.
