DAWES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Public convened meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners in regular session was commenced at the hour of 9:20 A.M. on the 9th day of November, 2021 pursuant to public notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Jake Stewart. Board Members present was Levi Grant. Commissioner Rivera and Deputy County Attorney, Adam Edmund, were excused from the meeting. Also present was Cheryl Feist, Dawes County Clerk and Wade Yada, Highway Superintendent. Per LB 898, Commissioner Stewart announced posted information concerning the Open Meetings Act is located on the Janitor's Door next to the American Flag. Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting. Motion by Commissioner Grant, seconded by Stewart approving the agenda and noting the cancellation of Mobius Communications appointment scheduled at 10:30 A.M. Roll call vote, Ayes: Grant and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Claims were reviewed. Commissioner Grant, seconded by Stewart, moved to approve all claims as presented. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Grant. Nays: None. Motion carried. Discussion ensued regarding the Treasurer issuing a check payable to the Imprest Account instead of calling in the certification amount to be transferred. The Board indicated for the record the Treasurer or someone authorized by the Treasurer will be responsible for depositing all checks issued for the Imprest Account as transfer of funds to the Imprest Account is a function of the Treasurer's Office. The Board acknowledged correspondence received from NCAP. The Board reviewed and approved by general consent the monthly fee/mileage reports of the various departments.

At 9:30 A.M. Wade Yada, Highway Superintendent, met with the Board. Road updates ensued to wit: **District 1**-Ormesher Road project is completed and ½ mile of Bordeaux Road will be graveled. **District 2**-Squaw Mound graveling project is completed and two (2) miles of Hollibaugh Road will be graveled. **District 3**-spot graveling on Haynes Roads. Commissioner Grant indicated Ferguson, Brown and all roads north of Whitney need addressed. Autogate repairs were also discussed.

In other business Commissioner Stewart read aloud a proclamation declaring November 13-21, 2021 as "National Hunger and Homelessness Awareness Week". Commissioner Grant, seconded by Stewart, directed the Chairman to sign the proclamation. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Grant. Nays: None. Motion carried. The County Clerk presented a lease renewal with Quadiant Leasing for the postage machine. The lease rate will remain the same amount as it has been in the past. Commissioner Grant, seconded by Stewart, moved to continue the postage machine lease with Quadiant per lease terms and directed the Chairman to sign such. Roll call vote, Ayes: Grant and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. A communications surplus request was reviewed by the Board. Commissioner Grant, seconded by Stewart, moved to approve the surplus request of the Communications Department. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Grant. Nays: None. Motion carried. Disposal of the equipment on surplus is planned due to it no longer working.

The next meeting of the Dawes County Commissioners will be held on November 29, 2021 beginning at 9:00 A.M. with the Commissioner Meeting. The meeting will be held in the Commissioner room. The agenda will close at noon on November 24, 2021. **All Resolutions adopted by the Dawes County Board of Commissioners are available for public inspection during normal business hours of the County Clerk's Office.**

Copies of the Act are available upon request by anyone attending the meeting or requesting a copy. Motion by Commissioner Grant, seconded by Stewart, approving the agenda. Roll call vote, Ayes: Grant and Stewart. Nays: None. Motion carried. Motion by Commissioner Grant, seconded by Stewart, approving the 10/12/ 2021 minutes as published. Roll call vote, Ayes: Stewart and Grant. Nays: None. Motion carried. The County Assessor presented tax correction #'s 5168-5175 for the Boards review and approval. After review of said tax corrections Commissioner Grant, seconded by Stewart, moved to approve tax correction #'s 5168-5175 and directed the Chairman to sign such.
